We welcome **Rev. Don Frampton** as our special guest preacher on **February 12th**, at 8 and 10 a.m. Don retired in 2019 after 24 years as Senior Pastor of St. Charles Avenue Presbyterian Church in New Orleans. During his years at St. Charles Ave, the church made missions a priority in their community and beyond. The church established a program called Rebuilding Hope in New Orleans (RHINO) in the wake of Hurricane Katrina and that work continues today. St. Charles Ave Church has housed and supervised over 9,000 volunteers and helped build some 50 Habitat for Humanity homes. In 2009, the church received the PC(USA)'s highest award for community service.
