This week at Shepherd's Place I was dancing with a man I will call Brad. Brad does not speak, has little interest in games or cards, and refuses to do art projects, but he loves to dance. When Toni does her magic on the piano, Brad is ready to stand up and move to the music. Mostly he just sways in place, but occasionally he will dip and kick his foot and chuckle. It may be the only time in his day that he does something fun, and his smile brings me to tears of joy and sadness. Another client, whom I will call Pete, gives me a hug when he leaves and says, "I love to come here and be with my friends." Brad and Pete are two of the many clients at Shepherd's Place, a respite center for persons living with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, Parkinson's, stroke, or Traumatic Brain Injury.

They come to First Methodist Church in Fairhope (Monday through Thursday from 9am – 1pm), and participate in games, singing, art projects, music, exercise, refreshments, and other activities that help to stimulate them and afford opportunities for activities with others like themselves in a loving and caring environment. This four-hour break also gives their caretakers time off for their own lives. Volunteering at Shepherd's Place is easy. We get an email on the weekend asking when and if we can come in on one day; there is no commitment for a specific time or date, just an opportunity to fit Shepherd's Place into our schedules. Janie Stone and I go there on Wednesdays most weeks, and it is a highlight of my life. This respite needs more volunteers; if you feel that you might be interested in serving there, please contact me or Janie, and come with us to visit on a Wednesday to see if this opportunity to serve works for you. Trinity Tables of 8 is a fun and exciting way to connect with people in the church. If you would like to meet others from Trinity in a casual and relaxed atmosphere, then this group is for you!

These meals provide singles, couples, and families an opportunity to share a meal as a church family. The purpose is to mix our members up so that new

relationships develop and grow. Each group plans its own meals and gets together once during each two-month period (Sept/Oct, Nov/Dec, Feb/Mar, April/May). The group can meet in one another's homes, at a restaurant, or anywhere else... it's up to you!
